- The Lord God will provide the setting.

We must urgently present Jesus as the answer, 2 Kings 20:19, 2 Chronicles 32:31.

- We must share Jesus while we still have time.

- We must share Jesus while they still have time.

- We must share Jesus while there still is time.

In these days what will we present to those who see our lives: the stuff God has given us or the Savior God has given us? The way we answer that question may impact people these days and generations to come.
